- Promotion, elaboration and testing of BSR-wide models of sustainable transportation alternatives (including the use of biofuels)
- Strategies, actions and investments for sustainable use of marine resources (**offshore wind energy**)
- Creation of **urban-rural partnerships** tackling common development problems (e.g. joint energy savings, alternative and renewable energy management)
- Preparation and implementation of joint strategies for energy saving
